





The Tandem Mobi system is so small that it can be worn almost anywhere, giving users greater discretion and comfort. This guide will provide some tips on how to wear and take care of the system.





Wear it on-body with a lightweight adhesive sleeve\* or clipped to clothing.



Slip it into the coin pocket of jeans (yes, it's that small!)

## **Freedom to Disconnect**

The Tandem Mobi pump can easily be disconnected from its infusion set site for a number of activities, including physical sports, saunas, swimming, and other spontaneous activities.

Different insertion angles and a variety of tubing length options provide even more ways the pump can be worn. **Flip to back** for full list of options.



## Things to Consider

- Orient the adhesive sleeve so that the LED Status Indicators on the insulin pump can be seen
- Consider the placement of the infusion set prior to placing the adhesive sleeve to avoid stretching the tubing
- Do not wear or place the pump more than 12 inches above the infusion site. It is also recommended that the pump and smartphone be worn at least 6.5 inches apart.
- When integrated with continuous glucose monitoring (CGM), wear the pump on the same side of the body as the CGM sensor
- Avoid exposing the pump to magnets or products with magnets
- Be careful when applying sunscreens, bug sprays, and lotions. Some products can cause the pump and cartridge plastic to crack which may result in over- or under-delivery of insulin.<sup>†</sup>

† If the Tandem Mobi system becomes exposed to household chemicals or skin care products, be sure to clean the pump immediately. Always wash your hands before handling the pump or cartridge after applying skin care products like sunscreen and bug spray. If you need to apply any of these products to your skin, we recommend you temporarily disconnect the infusion site from your body while applying and wash your hands thoroughly before connecting your infusion site back to your body. It's also important to avoid excessive exposure of your filled cartridge to direct sunlight as this may impact the effectiveness of insulin.

## How to Clean the Pump

It is recommended that the Tandem Mobi insulin pump be:

- Routinely cleaned, especially if exposed to dirt, dust, and skin care products
- Use a lint-free cloth dampened with warm water and a bit of mild dish detergent to wipe the pump
- Never submerge it in water or use any other liquid to clean it
- Use a soft towel to dry the pump

Note: Before cleaning, always suspend your insulin, disconnect your infusion set, and remove the cartridge.



## Users can have peace of mind in the event of accidental submersion in water.

The Tandem Mobi insulin pump is water resistant to a depth of 8 feet for up to 2 hours (IP28 rating). We do not recommend swimming, scuba diving, surfing, or any other activities that could submerge the pump in water for an extended period of time. Finding the right infusion set is an important part of successful insulin pump therapy. Choose from a variety of options.
