How to change a CGM sensor vs. a CGM transmitter when using two Devices

Changing a Sensor:

When replacing a CGM sensor, only perform the steps below on a SINGLE device. For example, if you have your pump and phone connected to your CGM transmitter you should only perform the steps below on your pump OR phone, **but not both**.

- 1. Select "Stop Sensor" on pump OR phone
- 2. Remove CGM sensor and transmitter from body
- 3. Remove CGM transmitter from the sensor and discard sensor
- 4. After waiting 15 minutes, place new sensor on the body and insert transmitter
- 5. Within 5 minutes of inserting sensor, select "Start Sensor" on the same device used in step 1
- 6. Enter sensor code, or once warmup period is complete, perform 2 fingerstick calibrations and enter the BG value from the blood glucose meter into the pump OR phone
 - a. The two initial fingerstick calibrations must be entered on the same device used in step 1. After initial calibrations, calibration can be entered on either device every 24 hours.
- 7. Other device will automatically join the sensor session and begin displaying data
 - a. This may take up to 10 minutes

Changing a Transmitter and Sensor:

- 1. Select "Stop Sensor" on pump AND phone
- 2. Remove CGM sensor and transmitter from body and discard both
- 3. After waiting 15 minutes, enter new Transmitter ID on either pump OR phone
- 4. Confirm new Transmitter ID on same device used in step 3
- 5. Place new sensor on the body and insert new transmitter
- 6. Within 5 minutes of inserting sensor, select "Start Sensor" on the same device used in step 3
- 7. Enter sensor code, or once warmup period is complete, perform 2 fingerstick calibrations and enter the BG value from the blood glucose meter into the pump OR phone
 - a. The two fingerstick calibrations must be entered on the same device used in step 3. After initial calibrations, calibration can be entered on either device every 24 hours.
- 8. Enter new Transmitter ID on other device
- 9. Select "Start Sensor" on other device
 - a. At this step, the customer should be in the warmup period on both devices
- 10. CGM data should start appearing on both devices within 10 minutes assuming no loss of connection
