With Set Units



- Understanding Set Units -

Set Units mean taking the same amount of insulin before each meal, such as always taking 10 units before lunch. You don't adjust set units based on your food or glucose level. Your healthcare professional will help decide if this method works for you and how much insulin to take.

Entering Set Units for the t:slim X2 Insulin Pump —





Tap Bolus.



Tap X to decline adding a Correction Bolus.



Tap the units to enter your Set Units then tap the check mark.



Confirm insulin amount and tap the check mark.



Review and follow prompts to deliver bolus.



It's best to bolus before meals. But if you forget, don't worry - Control-IQ+ technology has you covered with automatic insulin adjustments every 5 minutes and helpful AutoBoluses.
